Facts about Ny-Ålesund

• Population: 35 (winter) - 180 (summer - max)

Nationalities: 2 - 15Number of stations: 10Number of buildings: 60

• Total length of roads: 9.8 km

Distance to the North Pole: 1231 kmDistance to Longyearbyen: 107 km

• Radio silent village

- o Turn off mobile phone, Bluetooth, Wi-Fi
- o Includes also wireless keyboard and mouse
- o If you have equipment emitting frequencies, inform station leader (needs to be discussed with all stations)

• Kings Bay reception (Opening Hours from 8:00 – 16:30)

- o Bank
- Post office
- Small assortment of medication (there is also some at the Blue House
 → ask station leader)
- o Public phone

Service building:

- o Canteen
- o Information boards (General, Station information, News screen)
- Washing machines and dryers
- o Bed clothing/Towels

Meal times

- o Winter/summer (two shifts see infoboard for all meal times)
- Weekday/weekend (Saturday dressing code, bring your own wine/beer)
- o Late dinner (to be announced to the kitchen beforehand)
- o Packed lunch

Shop opening times

- o Monday & Thursday/Friday 17:00 18:00
- o Additional openings depending on tourist boats/visiting groups
- o Bring your flight ticket for beer and liqueur

Welfare

- Movies, books
- o Gym, sauna

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- o Cabins
- o Boats, kayaks, skis
- o Sunday evening: cinema

• Pub

Welfare: Saturday

o Kings Bay: Wednesday (only summer)

o Summer: Melageret; Winter: Zeppelin Lounge

General Rules

- o No pictures in the dining hall and after 22:00
- o Respect meal times and kitchen staff working hours
- O Do not remove cups/plates etc. from canteen (at least deliver it back asap)
- o Do not walk barefoot in the canteen
- o Wash your hands and dry them, antiseptic soap is available in the canteen hall (long-term staff are more sensible to germs than others)
- Tuesday Seminar: Please contribute!
- Check out at the reception ONE HOUR before your flight; Clean your room and your office/lab.

Safety in Ny-Ålesund and field

• Rifles

- Rifles can only be entrusted to people who had a training course (BHV and KingsBay valid for 3 years). On-site refreshment course compulsory each year.
- Rifles are compulsory outside the village (beyond the dogyard, beyond the Chinese station)
- Rifles in town have to ALWAYS be empty of rounds and the bolt has to be opened!
- Never point a rifle towards person even if rifle is not loaded. Consider the direction when half-loading/unloading your rifle!
- o After use the rifle has to be cleaned and store in the rifle safe (alternatively deposit safe for the bolt)
- o Never leave a rifle unattended with the bolt: if needed keep the bolt on you
- o For private trips pick up a rifle between 17:30 to 18:30 and with agreed time on week-end (to see with staff on duty)

Polar bears

- o All buildings are opened (except the shop)
- o If you see one in town, move slowly to a building
- o Contact the watchman immediately: 79 02 72 38
- o All buildings should have a phone with the watchman phone number
- o Report immediately to the Station Leader if you see a polar bear in the field

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• In case of emergency

- Contact station personal or, if necessary, Kings Bay watchman (no time to loose)
- Station personal: Radio channel P1
- o Kings Bay watchman: 7902 72 38
- o In summer there is a **nurse** in town. Contact Kings Bay reception in case you need assistance

• Alarms

- Fire: check the display of the fire alarm control system, take action if needed and if you can
- o **Tyfon:** go (warmly dressed) to the reception, bring the car to the reception if you are using it

Environmental considerations

• Restricted areas

- o scientific field
- o bird sanctuary (15 May 15 August)
- o cultural heritage
- o stay on the road!

• Waste management

- o 28 categories
- o Recycling stations in Servicebygget and (a small selection at the station and accommodations)
- o Please sort and dispose your own waste!
- o Disposal of needles and chemicals: Marine Lab
- Don't feed animals (foxes, dogs), there is rabies on Svalbard
- Avoid unnecessary use of car/scooter/boat
- Ny-Ålesund Mission Statement:
 - o Preserve the near pristine environment of the Brøgger Peninsula and the Kongsfjorden area, as well as cultural heritage of Ny-Ålesund
 - Keep local human environmental impact at the lowest possible level so as not to jeopardize scientific research and monitoring
- Svalbard Environmental Act, main principles

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The AWIPEV station

Station Staff

- o **Station Leader**: contact person between scientists and Kings Bay, administration, accommodation, field trip, safety equipment, weapons
- o **Logistics Engineer**: Field equipment, clothes, freight, boat, snowscooter, use of workshop and tools at Rabot
- Observatory Engineer: Use of workshop and tools at the observatory, computer and electronics support

Station Routines

- o Balloon release: daily, 10:4511:15 UTC
- o Station leader meeting (Wednesday 8:30am)
- o Station meeting (Friday 9:00am)

• Premises

- o **Blue House**: accommodation, offices and computer, living room, information, laundry
- Rabot: accommodation, office and computer, living room, workshop, laundry
- Observatory: offices and computer, seminar room, workshop; LIDAR (restricted access to the observatory) & FTIR measurements → safety introduction necessary
- o Corbel: field station, accommodation, workshop
- o **Cold Storage:** storage facility (ask Logistics Engineer)
- o Scooter garage: storage facility, gas bottles (ask Logistics Engineer)
- o Vaskeriet: (limited) warm storage, chemical lab

VHF

- Station watch channel: P1
- o P2: for long chats
- o P3 & P4 for group work
- Make short and clear sentences

Excursion Notice

- o To be filled together with Station Leader or base personal on duty
- o Hang the notice on the wall
- o Call upon return and remove notice from the wall
- Station personal can stop field excursion (bad weather, safety), collect information before the trip about possible hazards
- Check your insurance for private trips

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• Transportation

- o bikes with trailers and in winter the kick-sledge
- Diesel car Emily: restricted use, only permanent staff and external logistics are allowed to use it
- o Electric car **Goupil**: ask for availability (priority logistics and divers), take a VHF radio with you
- o **Boats:** survival suit with hood on! Minimum distance to glacier front of 200m, respect restricted areas, provide permits and exceptions. Not for private use (Velferden boats instead)
- o **Scooters:** car driving license needed. Helmet compulsory. Not for private use (rent from KingsBay instead see reception)
- List for availability of boats and scooters in Rabot → check with Logistics Engineer

• General

- o Please mark you samples in freezer and fridge (Content, name, date)
- o Do not pick up packages by yourself → ask Logistics Engineer
- o Do not place equipment into corridors (escape routes)
- o Wash your coffee cups :o)
- o Computer viruses: check your laptop, hard disk, memory sticks
- o Do not change bedroom without agreement of the Station Leader
- For use of field equipment and tools please sign white board in Rabot/Workshop in the Observatory

• Kings Bay technical maintenance and support, supply and other

o Any agreement with Kings Bay technical personal has to be discusses with the Station Leader (for coordination and invoicing)

Before leaving

- o Provide freight list 48hrs before your departure. Missing papers can impend shipment and delivery (freight list, customs declaration, dangerous good declaration, etc.). Check with Logistics Engineer
- O Do not leave equipment behind you without agreement of the station staff
- o Clean your office, the workshop and lab, empty waste bin
- o Do not leave chemicals or dangerous goods behind
- o Do not leave any food behind, remove everything from the fridge
- o clean the room (vacuum) and bring bed sheets to laundry
- o ask for getting your medical information (sealed envelope) back
- o pay for private phone calls (0.8 NOK/min)
- o Send us references of your publications
